

QUEEN'S BATON RELAY ROAD CLOSURES – 13 FEBRUARY

There will be a number of road closures and parking clearances during the Queen's Baton Relay on 13 February as part of a Victoria Police directive.

In addition to the below specified road closures, Victoria Police also require all parked vehicles along the east-bound side of Sturt and both sides of Doveton Street South to remain stationary once the Relay commences.

Marshals will be in place to monitor vehicle movements to ensure the safety of spectators.

Please note – road closure times are indicative only and may be subject to changes.

Block one closures 12 – 1.10pm

Rodier Street; Eureka Street; Scobie Court; Kline Street; Stawell Street; Charlesworth Street; Victoria Street (and Service Road); Chamberlain Street; Queens Street; Otway Street; Kings Street; Barkly Street; Mair Street.

Please note, Victoria Street will open once the convoy has passed this point

Block two closures 12 – 1.10pm

Victoria Street (and Service Road); East Street; Humfray Street South; Main Road; Little Bridge Street; Peel Street; Grenville Street; Sturt Street; Albert Street; Lydiard Street South; Townhall Lane; Armstrong Street South; Doveton Street South; Dana Street.

Please note, this block will reopen once the convoy has arrived at Dana Street Primary School

Block three 12.40 – 1.50pm

Dawson Street South; Eyre Street; Lyons Street South; Raglan Street South; Errand Street South; Drummond Street South; Dana Street; Sturt Street.

Please note, this block will reopen once the convoy has turned into Sturt Street.

Block four 1.10 – 2pm

Sturt Street; Windermere Street; Ascot Street South; Talbot Street South; Rippon Street South; Pleasant Street South and all adjoining laneways.

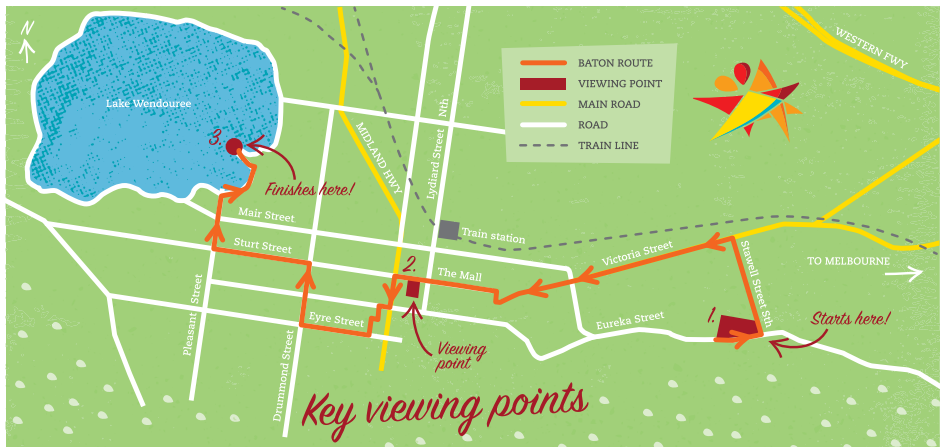
Please note, this area will reopen once the convoy has crossed over Sturt Street into Pleasant Street

Block five 2 – 3.15pm

Pleasant Street; Sussex Street; Kangaroo Place; Mair Street roundabout (this section will reopen) Block six 2 – 3.15pm

Pleasant Street; Wendouree Parade; Parade Court; Rippon Street; Webster Street; Victoria Avenue; Mill Street.

Please note, this section will reopen when the convoy leaves for Ararat.
