RESOLUTION:

- Give Public Notice in accordance with section 55 of the Local Government Act 2020 (the Act) of Council's intention to adopt, at a Council meeting to be held at 6.30 pm on Wednesday 23 June 2021, the proposed 2021-2025 Revenue and Rating Plan prepared in accordance with sections 93 and 94 of the Act.
- 2. In accordance with the provisions of Section 171 of the Local Government 1989, Council will waive \$95.00 of the Rates Levied for the 2021-22 year on properties where the ratepayer:
 - a) Is an eligible recipient within the meaning of the State Concessions Act 2004, and has qualified for a waiver under Section 171(4) of the *Local Government Act* 1989 (the 1989 Act), and,
 - b) Who lives alone in their own home and is solely responsible for the payment of rates and charges on that property.

- 2. Authorise commencement of the statutory process for the Mayor and Councillor Allowance in accordance with Part 5 of the *Local Government Act 1989*, by giving public notice of its intention to make the Mayor and Councillor Allowance and inviting submission under section 223 of the Act;
- 3. That the Chief Executive Officer be given the authority to make all administrative arrangements in relation to conducting a meeting under s223 of the *Local Government Act 1989*:
- 4. Receive a report to the 23 June 2021 Council meeting for the consideration of adoption of the Mayor and Councillor Allowances.
