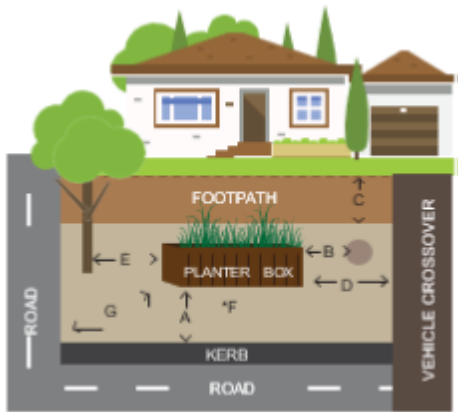


NATURE STRIP PLANTER BOXES



Planter boxes must be:

Made from timber or a suitable prefabricated material and be 40-100cm high including vegetation to avoid being a trip hazard or impacting sight-lines.

A: Minimum 1m clearance from back of kerb.

B: Minimum 1.5m clearance from pits, poles, furniture, hydrants, etc.

C: Minimum 1.5m from planter box to property boundary.

D: Minimum 2.5m from planter box to driveway/vehicle crossover

E: If the proposed works are within 2m or 12 times the trunk diameter measured at a height of 1.4m of any tree, whichever is the greater, approval must first be given by a City of Ballarat Arborist. Clearances will be determined on a case-by-case basis, depending on existing trees.

F: Nature strip underneath planter box must be soil to allow water to pass through. Area outside planter box may be other suitable aggregate if a nature strip alteration permit has been approved.

G: Planter boxes must be a minimum 10m from an intersection, or 20m where there are traffic signals at the
