Ballarat Aquatic and Lifestyle Centre

In the year to date:

- 616,062 people have attended the Ballarat Aquatic and Lifestyle Centre
- 42 schools enrolled in Active Schools Learn to Swim program

Road Maintenance

Maintaining roads and footpaths to keep the community safe.

- 1,200km of sealed roads
- 390km of unsealed roads
 - 994km of footpaths

Waste Services

In the 2022/23, the City of Ballarat:

- Collected 1,321 tonnes of glass from 'Pass on Glass' drop off points
- Collected 6,425 tonnes of recyclables
 - Deposited 23,216 tonnes of rubbish in Ballarat landfill







Community Events

- Ballarat Begonia Festival attracted more than 65,000 people
- Ballarat Heritage Festival –
 contributed more than \$1 million to the
 Ballarat economy
 - Summer Sundays concert series

Biodiversity

In the last financial year:

- Planted 1.967 trees
- Planted about 2,000 young trees, smaller plants and ground covers/ grasses, all grown in Ballarat's

asses, all grown in Ballarat's Indigenous nursery

Ensuring children in Ballarat have the best start to life. In the last financial year, there were:

 8,011 enrolments in the Maternal Child Services program, with 1.301 new enrolments
