Up to \$4.5 million (fully scalable)

- Up to \$500,000
Wendouree Electorate (Includes the Council wards of Alfredton, Central, Delacombe, Sebastopol, and Wendouree)

- Up to \$2.5 million

Project Description

A package of footpath upgrades at various locations across Ballarat's urban area to be delivered over multiple years and including stakeholder engagement, survey and detailed design.
